DEROGATION FOR European County Board: A player may play with her home Club in Ireland and a Club in her EU Country of study and vice versa, provided she is participating in a recognised programme of study in another EU Country, or Ireland, for at least six months duration and she obtains permission from Ard Chomhairle using the official Student Permit Form. These players may play with their home Club or County in their respective championships or other competitions. This does not apply to players whose home club is in Ireland or Britain, studying elsewhere in Ireland or Britain.

## Requirements

- Camogie Players who are travelling to Europe for the summer <u>MUST</u> be registered club
  members in order to receive a sanction to allow them play on a temporary basis with clubs
  in these areas.
- It is mandatory that all players obtain appropriate insurance cover before a permit to Europe can be granted. Sanction/permit requests will only be considered where such request is accompanied by a Certificate of (Travel) Insurance issued by AIG Europe S.A. and arranged directly with AIG via the dedicated GAA Phone Number 01 261 1419 no other insurance will be accepted.
